

If I were interested in this particular town that would be fine. I think the title does disservice to what this book is actually about. I am a lifelong fan of Gladys Taber's Stillmeadow books so perhaps I have a different perpective on books purporting to be about love affairs with old houses. If I had known how little there was about the house itself and this couple's love affair with it, I never would have purchased this, and it will not be a permanent addition to my library.
